KPC Respite Center

I'm part of a unique community service organization right here in the neighborhood: KPC Respite Center, a minstry of Lutheran Family Services. KPC is a crisis center that provides short term, temporary child care for children whose families are experiencing extreme challenges such as homelessness, loss of job, domestic



violence, or other critical, unforeseen life circumstances. Most of the children that come to KPC are under the age of 6, but in some cases siblings up to 12 years old can be accommodated.

KPC creates a nurturing environment and uses low childstaff ratios to promote individual attention for each child that comes into the center. We are even licensed to keep children for



up to 3 days in emergency situations. Everything is provided for the children when they are here. We have strong relationships with

many other organizations and resources in the community which is how many of our families find us. This also helps to provide natural connections for families that need additional assistance. The staff at KPC get to hear countless stories of parents and caregivers that are shocked and grateful for a place to bring their children when they are in some of the most vulnerable situations in life.
